DOG PARK RULES



The use of our Stephens Valley Dog Park is conditioned upon strict adherence to rules which are intended to create a safe and pleasant experience for all dogs and their people. Stephens Valley reserves the right to deny access to anyone found breaking the rules.

- When outside of contained areas, leash laws shall be observed. Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and exiting the fenced areas.
- Use of the dog park is at the Resident's risk.
- All Handlers must be at least 16 years of age and a resident of Stephens Valley.
- For safety reasons, children under the age of 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult and may not be unaccompanied in the park.
- All dogs must be wearing current identication tags at all times.
- Residents must remain in the dog park and supervise their dog at all times when the dog is in the park. Residents must have a leash on hand for each dog at all times.
- Dogs that become aggressive must be leashed immediately and removed from the dog park. Residents are legally responsible for injuries inicted by their dog and nes will apply.
- Disposal of all dog waste, either in the provided trash receptacles or by removal from this area, is required.
- The following are not permitted in the Dog Park:
 - A. Any dog that exhibits or has a history of aggressive behavior;
 - B. Female dogs in heat;
 - C. Puppies under 8 weeks of age;
 - D. Dogs without handler supervision;
 - E. Spiked collars and dog toys;
 - F. More than two dogs per handler;
 - G. Dogs that are not current with vaccinations;
 - H. Dog grooming; and,
 - I. Human/Dog food or treats of any kind.
- The use of the Dog Park is for residents of Stephens Valley and their pets. Organized activities such as shows, competitions, pet adoptions, organized training, and fund raisers are prohibited.
- Any incident must be reported to management immediately.
- Between the hours of 9:00pm to 8:00am is quiet time, please refrain your dog from barking as to not disturb our neighbors.
